Examples of **on buttons** in the law:

- Life, Liberty, and the pursuit of Happiness
- Freedom of speech, assembly, and press
- Freedom from unlawful searches
- Right to due process
- Rights to: a speedy public trial, a lawyer, an impartial jury, confront witnesses, know the charges and evidence against you (in criminal cases)
